

Dress Code as stated in the Burhill Bye Laws Summer 2005

Dress code for all members, their guests, and visitors is as follows, both on and off the course:

No denim jeans, plimsolls, flip flops or trainers.

All shirts should be tucked into waistbands and have collars and sleeves.

Golf caps should be worn with peak forward.

In addition for men:

Long tailored shorts are allowable, when appropriate, but must be worn with white sports socks above the ankle.

Combat style $\frac{3}{4}$ length shorts / trousers may not be worn.

Jackets and ties should be worn in the Dining Room at all times unless relaxed by the Captain or Company.

In addition for ladies:

Ladies may wear sleeveless shirts but they must have a collar.

Long tailored shorts may be worn.

Please note that changing of clothes or shoes should take place in the changing rooms, and not in the car park or on the course.
