Conditions of the Competition



Format

On Wednesday, 25th August there will be an 18 hole Foursomes Stableford Competition for the Langmead Morgan Trophy.

The knockout stages for the Family Foursomes will be played on the **Thursday, Friday and Saturday.**

The draw for the Langmead Morgan Trophy will be made at the end of July and will be distributed shortly afterwards.

Tees

Men, and boys aged under 14 on the 25th August 2010 with handicaps of 28 or less, play from the white tees.

Ladies, girls and any other boys aged under 14 on the 25th August 2010 play from the red tees.

Handicap Allowances and sudden death play-off rules

The Competition is a Knockout over the Old Course, by 18 Hole Foursomes Match Play throughout.

The aggregate handicap of the partners is limited to 36.

The handicap allowance for this competition is 3/8 of the full difference between the aggregate handicaps with ½ strokes to count as one. Strokes are taken according to the Men's Score Card Stroke Indices.

In the event of a match being all square after 18 holes, players continue to play the 1st, 2nd, 3rd in a sudden death play-off strokes still being taken in accordance with the Men's Stroke Card Indices.

Entries

Entries made on the printed Entry Form, accompanied by the Entrance Fee will be accepted on a first come, first served basis, limited to 64 entries.

The Committee reserves the right to replace those who withdraw after the draw has been published from those wishing to play on a waiting list of late entries or to modify the draw to avoid unfair advantage being gained from multiple walkovers or byes.

The closing Date for Entries will be at Close of Business on Friday, 23rd July 2010.

There will be no refund of Entry Fees after the draw has been made.

The Committee reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry without assigning a reason.

Additional Competitions

On Friday, 27th August there will be an optional Greensomes Stableford competition for the Lady Lennox Boyd Salver for competitors who lose on the first day of the Family Foursomes, which will be held on the New Course.

On Saturday, 28th August there will be a further Competition over the Old Course, for the Anna Cowan Trophy, open to all those who do not reach the semi-finals

Both these competitions will be Stableford and the handicap allowance will be ½ of the aggregate handicap of the partners, with ½ strokes to be counted as one. Strokes to be taken from the Men's Indices.

The aggregate handicap of the partners is limited to 36 in all 3 competitions.

In the event of a tie, the results are decided over the last nine, last six, last three and last hole as necessary.
